


The Segment

The Segment is created as a separate form component which contains the Checkboxes or mark areas which are used for the capture of response data by the OMR form processor.

When you create a New Segment the segment barcodes are automatically generated by default.

The Checkbox tool -  - is used to add the Checkboxes in groups of 4, which are contained within a Mark Area which is

called a Fragment in the Recognition Preview.

The number of checkboxes and their style can be changed in the Mark Area Properties dialog box which is accessed by double clicking on any mark area that you want to change.
